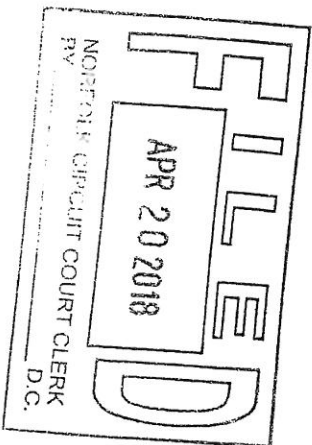

The undersigned Applicant states under oath:

1. A search is requested in relation to an offense substantially described as follows:
Violation of Virginia State Code 18.2-32 to wit: Murder
Violation of Virginia State Code 18.2-53.1 to wit: Use of a Firearm in the Commission of a Felony

2. The place, person, or thing to be searched is described as follows:
Google Inc., [REDACTED] Mountain View, California 94043 conducting business in the Commonwealth of Virginia while incorporated at [REDACTED] DE 19808. This affidavit believes that the records requested are actually or constructively possessed by a foreign corporation that provides electronic communication service or remote computing service within the Commonwealth of Virginia. This request is under the authority of Virginia State code 19.2-70.3.

3. The things or persons to be searched for are described as follows:

4. The material facts constituting probable cause that the search should be made are:
On 12/31/17 at 1948 hours, the Norfolk Police Department, along with Norfolk Fire & Rescue, responded to [REDACTED] Virginian minivan parked in the driveway suffering from multiple gunshot wounds. [REDACTED] transported the victim, identified as Caroline Hendrix, to Sentara Norfolk General Hospital with life-threatening injuries where [REDACTED] pronounced

Hendrix deceased at 2031 hours.

On 12/31/17 at 2059 hours, Virginia State Police responded in the City of Chesapeake for a gunshot victim who was identified as Edward Shaw: white male with a date of birth [redacted] who called 911 to report that he had been shot. Shaw made statements to Virginia State Police Investigators that he was shot during a road rage incident.

A witness to the incident [redacted] a white male with a date of birth [redacted] stated he observed the suspect who he described to this affiant. [redacted] further stated he was armed with a firearm and returned fire at the unidentified suspect to whom [redacted] believed he had shot. [redacted] also described the vehicle the suspect was driving to this affiant. The description of the suspect, suspect vehicle, and where the suspect was shot as described by [redacted] closely resembled the description of Edward Shaw, Shaw's vehicle, and the location of Shaw's gunshot wounds. Shaw's personal property was collected during the State Police investigation which included a black LG cellular phone with serial number [redacted]

This affiant secured 2nd Degree Murder & Use of a Firearm during the Commission of a Felony warrants against Edward Shaw for which he was later arrested.

This affiant obtained and executed a search warrant on the black LG cellular phone which contained a user account [redacted]

This affiant observed emails between email account [redacted] address [redacted] and [redacted] home address), and address [redacted] where [redacted] prior to the shooting on 12/31/2017. In one email, user [redacted] Virginia Drive are discussed and I discussed, if he dies and either of us get caught...then both are charged with "Conspiracy" and both are equally guilty, regardless of who carries out the deed."

For the above cited reasons, this affiant requests a search warrant for any and all records and subscriber information associated with the Google account associated with the email account [redacted] maintained by Google, Incorporated at [redacted] Mountain View, California 94043, relating to the offense of Murder and Use of a Firearm in the Commission of a Felony.

Through my training and experience, I have learned that most cellphones have an email address associated with the phone. The email account associated with these devices often times contains information such as location history, communications to codefendants about the crimes they commit, applications they use on their devices and pictures saved on their devices. This information can help prove that individuals committed crimes and implicated others involved in these crimes. These
