Stipulation of Commonwealth's Evidence

The parties agree that the Commonwealth's evidence would show that on or about November 24th, 2018, the defendant committed the following offenses in the City of Virginia Beach: Carnal Knowledge of a Minor, Procure Minor for Obscene Material, Possess with the Intent to distribute > 1/2oz < 5 lbs.
