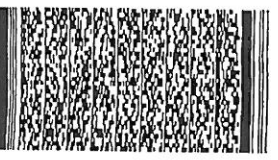

I base my belief on the following facts:

On 9/16/2019, at 2112 hours, Newport News Police Officers were dispatched to Dresden Drive #1B for a shooting. Officers arrived on scene, located Javon Fraser outside suffering from gunshot wounds.

Officers also located a second victim (Kayleigh Ellifritz) inside of the residence, suffering from multiple gunshot wounds. Medic #8 arrived on scene and medics pronounced Ellifritz deceased at 2123 hours. Fraser was transported to Riverside Hospital for treatment. Detectives responded to Riverside Hospital to interview Javon Fraser in reference to this incident. Over-->

CRIMINAL COMPLAINT -- ATTACHMENT

I base my belief on the following facts:

During the interview with Javon Fraser, detectives found that he was at home with his wife and children. Suddenly, while the kids were eating on the floor, the front door was kicked open. Fraser was on his way to the bathroom when he heard gunshots. Fraser advised that the male entered the residence, but did not say a word and just started shooting.

This affiant conducted a second interview with Fraser. Fraser stated he was on the way to the bathroom, when he heard what appeared to be someone kicking at the door. Fraser made his way towards the living room from the bathroom. Even though Fraser had a white cloth tied around his face, Fraser could see the males eyes and his tattoos. Based on seeing the suspects eyes and tattoos, Fraser has no doubt the suspect was Jonah Sims. Fraser stated Sims did a poor job attempting to conceal his identity. Fraser has known Sims from Middle School in 2010-2011, till they were both placed in the same foster care home in Gloucester in 2012. According to Fraser, Sims and his girlfriend moved into Dresden Drive #1B two months ago. On Wednesday or Thursday, Sims and his girlfriend were kicked out of the apartment by Fraser and Ellifritz.

Fraser observed Sims with a chrome/black handgun. Fraser claimed Sims obtained the firearm last week when he traded a .22 caliber firearm for it, and has seen Sims in possession of the firearm when he was living with them. Sims was in possession of this firearm when he shot Fraser and Ellifritz.

Fraser was shown a blind-shuffle photospread containing Sims and at 2302 hours positively identified Sims.

This affiant is also aware of other details about this incident that were revealed during the investigation of this incident. The details listed herein are not an exhaustive listing, and are provided only to establish probable cause for the arrest of Sims.

It is requested that warrants be issued charging Jonah Dwight Sims with violations of Virginia Code 18.2-32, First Degree Murder; Virginia Code 18.2-53.1, Use of a Firearm in the Commission of a Felony x3, Virginia Code 18.2-51, Malicious Wounding; Virginia Code 18.2-90, ~~Carrying a Dangerous Weapon~~ with intent to commit a felony; ~~Carrying a Dangerous Weapon~~ or other felony; Virginia Code 18.2-279, Discharge Firearm within or at Building or Dwelling, Virginia Code 18.2-308.2, Possession of a Firearm by Convicted Felon.

Before me this date personally appeared (122244) WEBSTER, WADE K who being first duly sworn deposes and says that on 14th day of September, (year) 2019 at 696 DRESDEN DR APT. 1B, NEWPORT NEWS, the above named defendant committed the above offenses charged and the facts showing probable cause to believe the same are as follows:

On September 14, 2019 at approximately 1236 hours, in the city of Newport News, I was dispatched to Dresden Drive Apartment 1B in reference to an assault.

When I arrived on scene, I visually noticed when I made entry that the front door was un secure with the door frame inside broken off and the door lock (deadbolt) was knocked off. I made contact with Kayleigh Ellifritz who advised that Mr. Jonah Sims (he is an acquaintance of hers) kicked in her door and beat her up today. Ms. Ellifritz let Mr. Sims and his girlfriend hang out at her apartment on (09-13-2019) until Ms. Ellifritz came back home from church that evening. Mr. Sims and his girlfriend are currently homeless and just have some belongings in bags. When Ms. Ellifritz came back from church, Mr. Sims and his girlfriend's items were there but they were not so Ms. Ellifritz texted them to get their stuff but were being uncooperative so Ms. Ellifritz put it outside her apartment.

This morning on (09-14-2019), Mr. Sims came back to Ms. Ellifritz's apartment to try to get the rest of his belongings from the residence. Mr. Sims was banging on the front door and the bedroom windows trying to get his belongings. Ms. Ellifritz then came to the front door and told Mr. Sims that his stuff was not here and she wasn't going to let him in because her current husband was not there. Mr. Sims then stated "If you don't let me in, ima beat your ass" and then kicked in the door gaining entry into the apartment. Mr. Sims then started to push and punch Ms. Ellifritz multiple times until she fell on the ground. Ms. Ellifritz has two visible bruises on her right cheek and one on her forehead. Mr. Sims then looked around for his items but did not find any. During the altercation, Mr. Sims dropped his Virginia identification card and octapharma plasma debit card at the scene. Mr. Sims then grabbed Ms. Ellifritz's phone

Mr. Sims then made entry into the residence again until Ms. Ellritz told him to leave, which he stated "next time answer the door or he was beat my ass again" Mr. Sims then left with his girlfriend who was outside the apartment.
