

On May 17, 2021, Officers were dispatched to 3500 Clover Road apartment #103 for a possible abduction. The witness called Chesapeake Police Department claiming he was on the phone with his wife the victim. While the witness was speaking with the victim he heard her scream and what appeared to be a struggle right after. The phone call was disconnected. The witness made numerous attempts to call the victim back, but the victim never answered the phone. The witness started to receive unusual text messages from the victim that she would never write, for example he received a text claiming she was okay and the victim only writes ok when using that word. The victim always ends a conversation saying she loves the witness and today she did not write that to him.

A search of the area was conducted and the victim's car was located parked on the opposite side of the apartment complex. The victim's vehicle was checked and there appeared to be blood drops and blood smear marks in the back of the vehicle's tail bed. A welfare check was conducted inside apartment #103 where the victim was living and she was not inside. A complete search of the residence is needed to determine if a struggle or assault occurred. The collection of the evidence will be needed if a crime occurred inside apartment #103.

TO ANY AUTHORIZED OFFICER:

You are hereby commanded in the name of the Commonwealth to forthwith search the following place, person or thing:
3500 Clover Road apartment #103 is a single story residence with white siding and a blue front door located in the City of Chesapeake. The numbers "103" is affixed on the siding to the left of the front door.

..... for the following property, objects and/or persons:
Items or evidence that would indicate a struggle or an assault. Items to include DNA evidence such as trace evidence, and latent fingerprints.

- This SEARCH WARRANT authorizes a search of a place of abode which may be executed by initial entry of the abode
- only in the daytime hours between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., unless prior to the issuance of this SEARCH WARRANT, law-enforcement officers lawfully entered and secured the place to be searched and remained at such place continuously OR
