Victim(s): Moore, William I. (W/M/83) Homicide Hubbard, Connie F. (W/F/63) Malicious Wounding

Suspect(s): Hudspeth, Xavier E. (B/M/19) Moore, Andra D. (B/M/19)

On 02/28/22 at 2217 hours, Norfolk Fire and Rescue along with the Norfolk Police Department responded to 9294 Philip for two gunshot victims.

- Upon arrival, emergency personnel located Moore unresponsive with a gunshot wound to his head in the living room.
 - Engine 13 responded and pronounced Moore deceased at 2029 hours.
- Hubbard was located at a neighbor's house and provided a description of the suspect.
 - Hubbard was transported to SNGH with a gunshot wound to the head with life threatening injuries.
- ❖ BOLO was put out and as officer's arrived, both suspects were detained a short distance from the crime scene.

Victim: Moore, William I. (W/M/83) No Gang Affiliation

- > Moore was inside his residence with his daughter, Hubbard.
- Moore was located in the living room laying on the floor suffering from a gunshot
- It appears that Moore was watching TV in his chair and went to the door to open it, based on the close proximity of his body.
- Moore is a retired Norfolk Police Officer who retired in 1994.

Vicitm: Hubbard, Connie F. (W/F/63) No Gang Affiliation

Hubbard was located at the next-door neighbor's home who called 911.

- > Hubbard stated that she was in her bedroom when she was accosted by a skinny black male who took her cellular phone as she tried to call 911.
 - Described the suspect as a tall skinny black male wearing possibly tan jeans.
 - O Stated the male left through the back door.
 - o Did not provide names of the suspect.
- > Hubbard sustained a gunshot wound
 - o Hubbard was transported to SNGH with life threatening injuries.

Witness:

- > Called 911 a few minutes before the gunshot disturbance.
- > Observed two (2) black males walking in the area as they were looking into houses.
- > When she heard the gunshots, she observed one (1) of the black males riding in circles on a bike in front of her house.
- > A few minutes later she saw the other black male walking to the male on the bike.
 - o They stood there and talked, looked around and took off running down Mason Creek.

Witness:

- 8
- > Stated that she heard gunshots with two (2) followed by two (2) more.
- > When she looked outside, she saw her neighbor walking in circles in the street and went to see what happened.
 - O She called 911 and relayed the message.
 - O She observed blood on her face and brought her inside her home.
- > Hubbard began to tell her that a tall skinny black male came inside and shot her father in the head.
- > She tried to call 911 but the male took her phone and ran out the back door.
 - O She denied knowing the suspect.

Suspect: Hudspeth, Xavier E. (B/M/19)

- > Hudspeth was located walking on Ridgewell Avenue and detained by
 - Hudspeth was transported the POC where he was advised oh his Legal Rights and agreed to speak with detectives.

- Hudspeth stated that Brown came to his house and asked him to ride out to Ocean View with him.
 - o Brown was on his bicycle and Hudspeth was on foot.
- > Hudspeth stated that when he got to the location he was on the bicycle and Brown went to the house.
 - o They are familiar with the house because they were "told" by some lady that they sale "sticks" (guns) out of the house.
- Hudspeth stated that Brown went to the house while he stayed outside on the bike.
- > Hudspeth heard gunshots and saw Brown come to the back door and motioned for him to come in.
 - He did not want to go in and be a part of anything that just happened.
 - o Brown was trying to hand him the gun and he refused to take it.
 - Hudspeth stated that he ran, and he does not know what happened to the gun
 - o Brown also stated that her phone however he threw it over the fence in the neighbor's back yard.
- > Hudspeth described that Brown is money hungry and that is the only reason that he would have gone there.
 - He is aware that he carries a Glock 40 caliber firearm and has seen it and possibly touched it the night before.

Suspect: Brown, Andra (B/M/19)

- > Brown was located in the 9200 blk 1st View Street by Officer Woods
 - o Brown was transported to the POC.
- > Brown was advised of his Legal Rights and agreed to speak with detectives.
- > Brown denied knowing why he was at the POC.
- > Brown stated that he did not have a gun and repeatedly denied knowing what happened.
- > Brown stated that he was with his cousin however he would not provide his name for he did not like the police and would not talk.
- > Brown stated that he did not know the area for he was from Park Place/ODU area and was with his cousin.
- > Brown was found with a 40-caliber extended magazine on his person and he had no explanation.
 - o There was a mixture of PMC, Hornady and GFl cartridges
- Detectives later went back to the scene and located the firearm after Hudspeth advised the detectives of the location

- > Brown was shown photos of the firearm that was located in the bush and stated that he left the gun in the bush because he got scared
- > Brown stated that he was at that house because he heard that the man there built guns
 - o Heard it from the street
- > Brown stated that he did not think anyone was home and the male came to the door when he knocked
 - He got scared and then heard someone in the back and did not know anyone was there
 - O Saw a female and she was on the phone calling the police
 - O He grabbed the phone and tossed it somewhere
- > Brown stated that the only guns he saw were the rifles and that was not what he was looking for
 - o Denied taking anything from the house
 - o Brown only wanted guns because he has no money and he wanted a gun collection
 - o Brown was unable to state how many times he shot
- > Brown stated that he ended up being the one going into the house because the person he was with stated that the man knew his face

Crime Scene(s) - Evidence Collected (Summary)

9294 Phillip Avenue

- o 40 cartridge casings x 5
- o Multiple swabs
- o Cellular phone
- o Cartridges are the same make as the top two (2) in the magazine found on Brown's person.
- o Glock 40 caliber firearm S/N ADXM588 (Stolen Norfolk-2102080000363)-larceny from a garage 02/08/21
 - There are no leads or cameras in the area
 - Victim was staying with the friend and had to store the firearm in the garage because roommate did not want it in the house
- o Located the missing victim's phone in the neighbor's backyard that was taken by Brown

Canvass

- Extensive canvass was conducted to locate the firearm with no success.
 - o Going back out doing the daylight

911 Call

- > 911 call came in for a suspicious situation of two (2) black males walking up and down the street and one is on a bike.
- > It appeared that they were looking in houses.
- > 911 Call came in afterwards for the gunshot victims as seeing the same males in the area.

Video Surveillance

Ring doorbell camera close to the crime scene shows two (2) black males going up and down the street. One (1) of the males is on a bike while the other male is on foot.
