Police responded and detained two individuals in the area transported them to the Police Operations Center, both individuals had cell phones on their person. Detective Austin responded to the crime scene and observed an elderly male deceased on the living room floor with multiple gunshot wounds. Detective Austin responded to the Police Operations Center and interviewed Xavier Hudspeth, Mr. Hudspeth identified the white iphone taken from his person as his phone, and admitted to being at the scene but not knowing what was going to happen.
